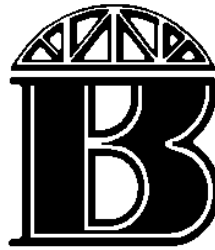

Old Business

1. Bruce Gabrian moved to table Attorney Young's language for section 1.02 – Form of Government, until the Commission discusses section 5.01. Motion was seconded by Tracy Cook and passed by a unanimous vote of the Commission.
2. Patricia Bland moved to accept Attorney Young's language for section Article VI – Boards and Commissions Section 6.03 as distributed. Motion was seconded by Ricky Breneman and passed by a unanimous vote of the Commission.
3. Bruce Gabrian moved to accept Attorney Young's language for section Article VI – Boards and Commissions Section 6.04 as distributed. Motion was seconded by Anthony Banks and passed by a unanimous vote of the Commission.
4. Jessica Perkins moved to accept Attorney Young's language for section Article VI – Boards and Commissions Section 6.08 – Police Commission as distributed. Motion was seconded by Bruce Gabrian and passed by a voice vote of the Commission.

New Business

1. Patricia Bland moved that Attorney Young draft language, as discussed, for Article VII – Financial Procedures, to include a Section 5 for Auditing, to be reviewed and considered at the next meeting. Motion was seconded by Ricky Breneman and passed by a voice vote of the Commission.
2. Patricia Bland moved that Attorney Young draft language, as discussed, for Article VIII – Personnel Procedures, to be reviewed and considered at the next meeting. Motion was seconded by Ricky Breneman and passed by a voice vote of the Commission.
3. Patricia Bland moved that Attorney Young amend section 6.07 - Planning Commission, from requiring 13 members to at least nine (9) members and make other changes as discussed to be reviewed and considered at the next meeting. Motion was seconded by Jessica Perkins and passed by a voice vote of the Commission.

4. Jessica Perkins moved that Attorney Young make recommended changes to Article IX – Planning and Zoning Procedures to be reviewed and considered at the next meeting. Motion was seconded by Bruce Gabrian and passed by a voice vote of the Commission.

General Discussion

Chairperson Perkins provided an overview of the remaining process of reviewing the Charter. She stated that she would like to see the review and revisions wrapped up by the end of May; then a Public Hearing would be scheduled in June for public input.

There being no further business, Patricia Bland moved to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Ricky Breneman and passed by a unanimous voice vote of the Commission.
