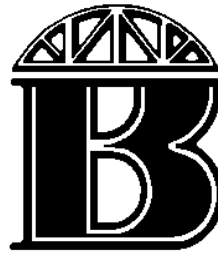


# City of Bridgeton

COVID-19 update: In order to be prudent and adhere to CDC recommendations, the Bridgeton Recreation Center will close our doors to the public on Tuesday, March 17 at 6 p.m. This closure will last at least through April 5<sup>th</sup> and we will reassess a potential reopen date in the weeks ahead.

All rentals, classes, and programs will be cancelled during this time. Our Older Adult Services division will continue Senior Van Transportation and Meals on Wheels, but will do so only with the utmost discretion and caution limiting to essential trips such as the grocery store and pharmacies.. Those with concerns about Older Adult Services should call (314) 687-4484.

To our renters and class/program participants: All classes have been canceled effective immediately. Our staff will be reaching out to you over the next few days with more information.

To our members: those with a monthly membership will see no withdrawal in April (both those with withdrawals on the 1<sup>st</sup> and the 15<sup>th</sup>) in order to compensate for the loss of service. Those with a current annual membership will have their membership extended for the duration of the facility closure. Extended stay members will be contacted.
