This Court can assist you with the following:

1. Addressing warrants and bonds issued from this Court;
2. Providing information about cases on the municipal dockets; and
3. Making payments for fines and court costs to the municipal court.

The following persons shall not enter the Bridgeton municipal courthouse:

- Persons who have traveled to any foreign country within the last 14 days;
- Persons who have traveled to states designated as “restricted” by the St. Louis County Department of Health, within the past 14 days. (For a current listing, see the St. Louis County Website: [www.stlcorona.com](http://www.stlcorona.com). Then click the “Update Travel List” button under “Areas of Community Transmission” on the right-hand side of the page.);
- Persons who reside or have had close contact with someone who has traveled to any foreign country or restricted area in the U.S. within the last 14 days;
- Persons who have been asked to self-quarantine by any doctor, hospital or health agency;
- Persons who have been diagnosed with or have had contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19; and
- Persons with unexplained fever, cough or shortness of breath.
